PROBLEM STATEMENT

The comprehensive academic program review process takes 9 - 21 months to complete. It is confusing to higher education institutions, department staff, and the Coordinating Board for Higher Education, leading to additional delays in submitting appropriate documentation, completing reviews, and final decision-making.

OUTCOMES

- Reduce process completion time to 9 months (max)
- 2. Increase institutional satisfaction to 100%
