

## OUR PROBLEM

School districts were reporting special education expenditures into two different web based application systems – one for annual auditing purposes and one to meet federal requirements. This dual entry process created duplicated effort, wasted time, and inaccuracies between the data. However, both systems were needed to meet different required reporting purposes.

## OUR FOCUS

Streamline the process for school districts when reporting special education expenditures, including: reduce the time needed to report expenditure data, remove duplicated effort by reporting the data only once, and increase the accuracy of the expenditure data.










We created a comprehensive coding system that allowed expenditure data from one webbased application system to automatically populate into the other web-based application system.
